

# Vocabulary Sort: flect, flex

deflect	A capable of <b>bending</b> without breaking
retroflex	B to <b>bend</b> or throw back light or heat; to fold or turn back
reflection	C an angle that is greater than 180 degrees because the angle is <b>bent</b> beyond the straight line
inflection	D the image in a mirror that is a result of <b>bending</b> light when it is thrown back
flexor	E the <b>bending</b> of a person's voice so that it does not sound boring or within only one tone; making one's voice go up and down
reflect	F to <b>bend</b> around or curve
reflex angle	G to turn or move to one side; to <b>bend</b> ; to swerve
inflexible	H <b>bent</b> or turned backward
circumflex	I a muscle that <b>bends</b> a part of the body, such as an arm or a leg
flexible	J capable of <b>bending</b> without breaking
